

Measures to Protect Your Health While Moving in a COVID-19 Environment



1	You are empowered to make decisions! Work with your chain of command and transportation office to reschedule your pack-out or delivery if you are not comfortable at any point during your move.

Know the symptoms! If you (or anyone in your home) is ill or has been
directed to quarantine, contact your transportation office to reschedul
your shipment.

- Limit the number of family members in the residence to those needed to supervise your move.
 - If this is not possible, prepare a dedicated room where family members can stay while personnel are working.
 - Moving companies have been directed to bring the minimum number of personnel required to handle the shipment.
 - Wear cloth face coverings. Everyone in your home, whether on or off a military installation, should wear a face covering in line with CDC guidelines. If shipping a vehicle, wear a face covering while at the Vehicle Processing Center.
 - All moving company personnel have been directed to wear face coverings while at your residence.

5 Routinely clean frequently touched surfaces.

Moving companies will be equipped and prepared to clean surfaces they frequently touched (they will seek your permission first).
